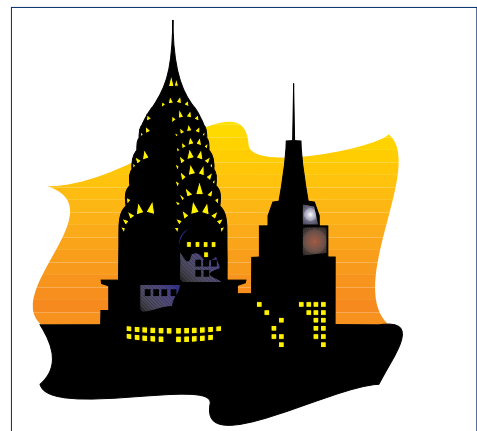

NOVEMBER PROGRAM November 29, 2006 NIKON HOUSE in MELVILLE

The November NCCC program will take place a week later than normal, on the 29th of the month since the 22nd is Thanksgiving eve. All members of the Nassau County Camera Club and their guests are invited to Nikon's International headquarters located minutes away from Levittown in Melville for a personalized program.

Stan Menscher, Nikon's Product, Technology and Engineering Rep. is putting together a program just for our members. We'll be treated to a powerpoint presentation of Nikon's latest and greatest digital cameras, lenses, flash systems, scanners and software. We'll be treated to an up close and personal hands on demonstration of all of the above where we'll be encouraged to ask questions about and play with some of the newest and most sophisticated photo equipment on the market.

To quote Stan: "Everybody has a brain, but frankly some people are smarter than others. Now 10 megapixel and higher cameras are the norm, but you can do more and get better results with Nikon because of the combination of intelligence, features and coordinated support thru accessories." (OK, so Stan may be just a little biased!)

Being mindful that many of us are still shooting film and then scanning our images and subsequently doing our own printing, Stan will also explain and demonstrate Nikon's very latest scanners, all of which are state of the art.

Finally, we'll be given a demonstration of Nikon's very latest software editing program, Capture NX, which is designed for NEF (Nikon raw) or JPEG (standard). This program represents a dramatic departure from the tedious ways of editing photographs using layers, while simplifying the task and speeding up the process.

The evening will be informative, fun and a refreshing departure from our regular meeting room. If you've never visited Nikon Headquarters, be assured it is a beautiful and stimulating building. And whether you are a Nikon fan or not, this evening will be chock full of information which will enhance your insights into digital photography and open your eyes as to the latest and most significant

photographic developments by perhaps the world's leading photographic company which just happens to be right in our own back yard.

We will meet at Nikon headquarters with the program commencing at 7:30PM (please note the early starting time). Specific directions will be provided about a week before our meeting.
